- **Best In Show** \$100 and Rosette
- **Grand Champion Hybrid of the Show** \$150.00 and Sash
- **Grand Champion Species of the Show** \$150.00 and Sash
- **Champion Sarcanthinae Species or Hybrid** \$50.00, Sash, and Ira Butler or Bill Murdoch Nomination
- **Champion Dendrobium Hybrid** \$50.00 and Sash
- **Champion Cyripedioideae Hybrid** \$50.00 and Sash
- **Champion Cymbidium Hybrid** \$50.00 and Sash
- **Champion Laeliinae Hybrid** \$50.00 and Sash

## **SECTION 1 - DISPLAYS**

Orchids in classes 1 and 2 are eligible for judging in other classes where appropriate, provided they are accessible to judges and have been nominated, if this is required. (See Condition 9.)

### **CLASS 1 Display**

To consist of a display of orchids and foliage of an area approximating 9 sq metres. All other entries in this Class not winning a prize to receive \$300 for exhibiting.

- **1<sup>st</sup> Prize \$400.00**
- **2<sup>nd</sup> Prize \$375.00**
- **3<sup>rd</sup> Prize \$350.00**

### **CLASS 2 Display**

To consist of a display of orchids and foliage of an area approximating 3 - 4 sq metres (floor display or table top). All other entries in this Class not winning a prize to receive \$150.00 for exhibiting.

- **1<sup>st</sup> Prize \$200.00**
- **2<sup>nd</sup> Prize \$180.00**
- **3<sup>rd</sup> Prize \$165.00**

### **VENDOR DISPLAY**

Displays by vendors will be judged separately, in the one category, and each display will receive the minimum prize money appropriate to the size of the display.

## **OPEN CLASSES**

Plants for prizes in any class in Sections 2 to 7 may be selected from all exhibits in the show subject to nomination requirements as outlined in condition (9).

Prize money in each open class shall be:

- **1<sup>st</sup> Prize \$10.00**
- **2<sup>nd</sup> Prize \$5.00**

Plants must be nominated for judging in classes marked # and §. Nominations should be in the hands of the Show Marshall by **3.00 pm Thursday 4th October 2018**.

## **SECTION 2: AUSTRALIAN NATIVE SARCANTHINAE**

### **Class 4 — # Native Sarcanthinae Species**

### **Class 5 — Hybrid Sarcochilus**

- (a) Predominantly white including white with a coloured centre
- (b) Any other colour or combination
- (c) Intergeneric Sarcochilus Hybrids.

Note: The judges will determine the class in which each plant is to be judged. All plants will be judged, but only in one category. The one panel will judge all classes.

### **Class 6 — Seedling**

- (a) # Pink or red
- (b) # Predominantly white
- (c) # Any other colour
- (d) # Intergeneric Hybrid
- (e) # Species

## **SECTION 3: EXOTIC HYBRIDS**

### **Class 7 — Cymbidium Hybrids**

- (a) Cymbidium over 60mm predominantly red or pink
- (b) Cymbidium over 60mm predominantly green or yellow
- (c) Cymbidium over 60mm any other colour or combination of colours
- (d) Cymbidium 35 mm up to and including 60 mm predominantly red or pink
- (e) Cymbidium 35 mm up to and including 60 mm predominantly green or yellow
- (f) Cymbidium 35 mm up to and including 60 mm any other colour or combination of colours
- (g) Cymbidium less than 35 mm predominantly red or pink
- (h) Cymbidium less than 35 mm predominantly green or yellow
- (i) Cymbidium less than 35 mm any other colour or combination of colours

### **Class 8 — Vandaceous Hybrids**

#### **Phalaenopsis**

- (a) White or pink Classical shape greater than 75mm
- (b) Any other colour Classical shape greater than 75mm
- (c) White and Pink greater than 51mm up to 75mm
- (d) Any other colour greater than 51mm up to 75mm
- (e) Any colour 50mm and under

#### **Vandaceous Other**

- (f) Vandaceous hybrids over 50mm
- (g) Vandaceous hybrids up to and including 50mm

### **Class 9 — Laeliinae Hybrids**

- (a) Greater than 115mm
- (b) Laeliinae hybrids 70 mm up to 115mm red or pink
- (c) Laeliinae Hybrids 70 mm up to 115mm yellow or orange
- (d) Laeliinae hybrids 70 mm up to 115 mm any other colour
- (e) Laeliinae hybrids up to 70 mm red or pink
- (f) Laeliinae hybrids up to 70 mm yellow or orange
- (g) Laeliinae hybrids up to 70 mm any other colour
- (h) Cluster Laeliinae hybrids (mimimum 6 flowers)

### **Class 10 — Paphiopedilum Hybrids**

- (a) Paphiopedilum including Parvisepalum and Brachypetalum
- (b) Maudiae type
- (c) Any other Cyripedioideae

### **Class 11 — Dendrobium Hybrids**

- (a) Dendrobium Soft Cane type, predominately White
- (b) Dendrobium Soft Cane type, predominately Pink
- (c) Dendrobium Soft Cane type Mauve
- (d) Dendrobium Soft Cane type, other colour
- (e) Other Exotic Dendrobium hybrids
- (f) **Dendrobium [Dockrillia] Hybrid** (including native hybrid Dockrillia)  
(The winner of this class is eligible for either Champion Native Hybrid or Champion Dendrobium Hybrid, depending on breeding)

### **Class 12 — Other Hybrids**

- (a) Pleurothallidinae 25mm and over
- (b) Pleurothallidinae under 25mm measured across the widest point
- (c) Oncidiinae up to and including 60mm in width
- (d) Oncidiinae exceeding 60mm in width
- (e) Any other GENERA

## **SECTION 4: EXOTIC SPECIES**

### **Class 13 — Exotic Species Americas §**

- (a) § Laeliinae
- (b) § Oncidiinae
- (c) § Pleurothallidinae
- (d) § Miniature (Flowers 15mm or less across the widest part of the flower & inflorescence < 150mm)  
*(miniature species should not be judged in other classes)*

### **Class 14 — Exotic Species Other (excluding Australia) §**

- (a) § Monopodial (Including Vandaceous, Phalaenopsis, angreacum and related genera, etc.)

- (e) § Miniature (Flowers 15mm or less across the widest part of the flower & inflorescence < 150mm)  
*(miniature species should not be judged in other classes)*

### **Conditions of Entry**

Initial results are tentative until all results are collated and finalised the following day.

1. All entries are free and open to Members of the O.S.N.S.W. and any other Affiliated Orchid Society.
2. Entries are received upon the basis that the Society or its sponsors shall not be responsible for any loss, destruction nor damage to such exhibits and the exhibitor shall have no claim against the Society or Sponsors.
3. Entries are accepted on condition that they are disease free. The decision of the Show Marshall shall be final.
4. All competitive entries shall have been owned and in the possession of the exhibitor for the preceding six months. This rule does not apply to Ferns or Foliage Plants used in the displays.
6. There shall be no restriction to the number of entries by an exhibitor in any class. Entries in joint names will be accepted.
7. The Show Marshal and Committee reserves the right to reject, remove or rearrange any exhibit without giving any reason for that action and to reclassify any plant if necessary, prior to judging.
8. Exhibitors may use Ferns and/or Foliage plants to embellish exhibits. Such plants are not considered in judging except for their decorative effect in displays. No flower or fruit other than Orchids or Anthurium may be used in any display.
9. Nominations for classes marked # or § must be in the hands of the Show Marshal by 3.00 pm on Thursday 4th October 2018. Please note: Judges have discretion to award plants that are not nominated.
10. All plants shall be in position ready for judging by 6.00 pm on Thursday 4th October 2018.
11. Entries are eligible for judging in one class only, except seedlings and specimens, where stated otherwise in the schedule.
12. If in the opinion of the Judges no exhibit in any class warrants a prize, none will be made. At the discretion of the Show Marshal additional classes may be included where warranted.
13. Plants for special prizes shall be selected from all exhibits in the show unless otherwise specified.
14. Judging shall be by a panel of Judges nominated by the O.S.N.S.W. Registrar and shall be in accordance with the standards and by-laws laid down by the O.S.N.S.W. Inc THE JUDGES DECISION SHALL BE FINAL.

15. No exhibit may be dismantled or removed prior to closing time of the show at 2.00 pm on Sunday 7th October 2018.
16. 'NOVICE' shall mean: Any exhibitor until she/he has won in aggregate first prize in any three genera or classes at any Orchid show or shows. The winning of the yearly point score in a monthly competition of any Society in any Genus/Class shall be deemed equivalent to a first prize in that Genus/Class. An exhibitor shall remain a Novice until the end of the calendar year in which the first prize for the third Genus/Class was won.
17. 'SEEDLING' shall mean the plant grown from seed and flowered for the first time. For exhibition purposes seedlings shall retain their status of 'Seedling' throughout the flowering season in which they first flower. Mericlones are not eligible as seedlings.
18. Staking shall be in accordance with the rules of O.S.N.S.W. i.e. flowers may be supported in the best possible manner for presentation. This supporting should be in such a manner so as not to be obtrusive and distract from the overall beauty and charm of the plant. With single flowered genera e.g. Paphiopedilum, Lycaste, etc., ties or support shall be no higher than immediately below the ovary. If it is necessary to tie above the bottom flower or top branch, the judges are permitted to penalise, or temporarily remove such tie for the purpose of judging.
19. When displays are being judged for arrangement and display, recognition will be given to displays which are uncluttered and spaced to best advantage. As a guide, approximately 25% of the floor area should be open to allow access to judges. Also displays should be dressed all round so as to present an aesthetically pleasing appearance.
20. The Show Marshall or his Appointed Representative has the right to remove any plant from any display or vendors Hall for any reason whatsoever.
22. Champion seedling is not to be considered for Grand Champion unless it has already won the Champion in its class.
